Junior Players has a 67-year legacy in the North Texas area, including innovative arts outreach, programming, and productions for some of the most promise-filled youth in our city's most historically marginalized BIPOC communities. As we near the end of 2022, I am proud of all of the major Junior Players accomplishments and commend all the work of our staff, board, advisory board, young professionals committee, teaching artists, and our community. It was a tough year with heightened expectations and every Junior Players stakeholder rose to the occasion! We also acknowledge the sudden hurdles that made our pathway more challenging, but certainly did not stop the work at hand. This year I want you to send accolades to the team behind the scenes, the unsung superheroes that make this all possible — my immense gratitude to the Junior Players Staff members! Junior Players has served over 300,000 kids and teens

Who all did we serve in 2022?

In 2022 alone, Junior Players served over 15,000 participants, 3,000 audience members, and produced over 2,000 FREE arts education programs!

Junior Players' participant demographic breakdown is 60% Hispanic, 30% African American, 7% White, and 3% Asian/Other.

Our ongoing COVID-19 Response:

Our team has worked tirelessly to remain present for the youth we serve through virtual and in-person programming despite the unprecedented challenges of the past couple of years. In response to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis, Junior Players offered all of our 2021/2022 programming in virtual, hybrid, and in-person models, dependent on sitespecific restrictions and procedures. While hybrid and virtual options still exist upon request, we are very happy to return to mostly in-person programs moving into the 2022/2023 school year.

EMPOWERING YOUNG VOICES


Junior Players has provided FREE arts education (including visual, performing, media, and dance) programming to the youth of North Texas since 1955. Junior Players continually adapts programming and outreach to meet the needs in our community. Each year, Junior Players serves thousands of kids and teens throughout the North Texas area. The below map indicates where Junior Players programs occurred in 2022. This map does not reflect an additional 155 camps that took place virtually all over the country.

Junior Players programs teach youth to resolve conflicts using non-violent communication strategies such as reflective listening skills, identifying emotions, and pivoting to non-violent solutions. All Junior Players programs are integrated with TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills) objectives for grades K-12, including 110) English Language Arts and Reading, 113) Social Studies, 116) Physical Education and 117) Art, Music and Theatre.

Junior Players' programming addresses the need of low-income and minority youths in North Texas by providing the following essential services traditionally not accessible to this demographic:

- · On-site access to high quality education enrichment programming
- · Constructive afterschool activities during critical out-of-school hours
- · Opportunities to develop technological, academic, and work force skill sets
- · Mentorship and positive adult role modeling
- · A platform to creatively express their unique ideas and perspectives
- · Programming focusing on civic engagement and current events
- Career and college pathways through hands-on experience and guidance
